

PETER WALSH WRITES AND SPEAKS ON MULTIJURISDICTIONAL PRACTICE OF LAW

Attorney Peter Walsh has published an article titled "Multijurisdictional Practice of Law Issues in Estate Planning," in the June, 2013 issue of the national estate planning magazine *Estate Planning* (an RIA Publication).
